## IN THE FIRST 6 MONTHS OF HER WORK IN THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT:

Miriam Dalli has been chosen to represent the Socialists and Democrats on **four reports**, concerning the following:

1. Reducing emissions from vehicles
2. Blue Economy,
3. European Strategy on Energy security
4. Interoperability systems for the reduction of bureaucracy in administration

Miriam Dalli has actively participated in the appointment of the new Commission and elected to put **four questions to the Commissioners designate**.

Miriam Dalli attended each of the **7 plenary session meetings** and gave her input in every vote.

Miriam Dalli put **20 parliamentary questions** to the European Commission including questions about the situation in Syria, online security, irregular immigration, climate change, Gender Identity, e-Commerce and Jobs in the field of ICT.

Additionally she had meetings with more than **20 international organizations** and senior officials of the European Commission in Brussels, and addressed three international conferences on immigration, energy and Child safety online.

In Malta Miriam Dalli held **20 meetings with unions, constituted bodies, NGOs, and student organisations**.

She also visited **2 schools, held 5 meetings with ambassadors to Malta** and **8 bilateral meetings** with Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries.

## WORK IN 2014



### IMMIGRATION

Dr Dalli has given this topic its due importance. Since her first days in parliament, the message Miriam put forward was that the inactivity of the EU in the field of immigration is leading to a greater number of deaths and increased pressure on European citizens. In the European Parliament Dalli said that our people feel they are abandoned and fed up and are now demanding solutions. This message was also passed onto Commissioner Malmstrom, who was responsible for this area, through direct meetings that Miriam Dalli had with her. Miriam Dalli was also invited to address an international conference in Brussels marking the 1st anniversary of the Lampedusa tragedy



### LIBYA - ISIS

During Strasbourg plenary speeches and other meetings Miriam Dalli stressed that instability in Libya is aiding human traffickers, that Libya is a European problem and that the EU must take a central role in resolving the situation. This has become even more important in light of the reports of the presence of ISIS in Libya.

### ONLINE SECURITY

Online Security is another main topic that Miriam Dalli has been working on. This attracted the interest of key stakeholders working in the field who invited her to address an international conference organised by the ICT Coalition. The Coalition brings together ICT companies (such as Facebook, Google, Twitter and Amazon) and NGOs with a view to making internet safer for our children. Miriam Dalli will continue to work for action in this area.



### CLIMATE CHANGE

Miriam Dalli is actively involved in work related to climate change, so much so that she was selected to be a speaker for a conference organized by Euronews and European Voice on the subject. With reference to the crucial summit in Paris next year, Dr Dalli has called for the EU to lead efforts aimed at reaching an agreement to reduce emissions and to generate cleaner energy.



### ENERGY

Miriam Dalli is one of the most active MEPs in the field of energy, and as a result was chosen by S&D to work on a report on a European strategy for Energy Security. Miriam Dalli called for an end to the situation where Member States are cut off from the European energy grid. She also insisted on priority being awarded to projects which are designed to end such isolation.
