Members are entitled to travel expenses to meet actual costs incurred in connection with missions (duty travel) undertaken in the performance of members' parliamentary duties (Brussels, Strasbourg and Luxembourg). Travel expenses are reimbursed on the basis of attestation of attendance available in the Chamber or Meeting rooms or in the Central Registry.

The flat rate allowance is intended to cover living expenses relating, amongst others to accommodation (including rent, lighting, water and heating, gas, cleaning, maintenance, insurance, condominium, laundry), hotels, meals, hospitality and other related expenses incurred during the members stay in the working places of the European Parliament. The daily subsistence allowance is only paid once Members' attendance has been attested by their signature in an attendance register provided for that purpose.
